Thanks for your questions. I'll try to be brief.

I am opposed to mainland development on Temagami outside the serviced downtown core. As a cottager and tax payer, I am committed to reduced taxation. I appealed my taxes this year but the issue we control is the mill rate. I propose a one year freeze while we reestablish our budget priorities. I support improved access etc on Temagami Access Road. We need to lobby Province as well as find some other sustainable sources of funding. I would support the user fees some are suggesting but need to see a business case. My fear is we inherit a huge administrative nightmare and don't raise significant dollars. Issues related to First Nations and tourist camp guests, businesses need resolution. *'m not sure of the municipal role in Houseboat issue. I think issue needs more scoping before I'd commit municipal funds.*
